## **ORDER:**

- 5. The Special Chief Secretary, GVWV&VSWS is requested to develop app\Website and also to provide login credentials to the Special Officers for uploading the inspection reports.
- 6. All Secretaries\HoDs\ Collectors are requested to analyse the inspection reports and submit the ATRs to the Chief Secretary periodically.
